

Parade of Homes Coming Soon!

PLYMOUTH, WI: Aug. 31, 2011 – The Sheboygan County Home Builders Association expects almost 2,000 people to tour the seven homes included in the annual Parade of Homes™. This year for two weekends, beginning September 9th through September 11th and again September 16th through September 18th the community is able to take a tour of newly constructed homes found throughout Sheboygan County.

Parade hours are Saturday and Sunday from 11:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. and Thursday and Friday, 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. One ticket provides access to each home entered in this year’s tour. At the time of purchase, buyers receive a book detailing the features of each home and a map showing them the best route to each home in the tour. Tickets can be purchased for \$9.00 per person at any Parade home or for \$7.00 at designated ticket sales sites throughout Sheboygan

County and the SCHBA Office located at 435 E. Mill Street in Plymouth. Children 3 and under are free if parents are able to carry them through the homes.

Again this year the guide books will be available FREE at your local grocery store, mini mart, bank and possibly in your hairdresser's waiting room. Included in the book is a list of ticket sales sites which will give you the opportunity to save \$2.00 per ticket if it is purchased in advance.
